



2020 Year 3-4 Junior Basketball League - Registration Information Term 1 and Term 2

*** Registrations close Sunday, 9 February**

IMPORTANT UPDATE - To ensure your child is placed in a team for 2020, registration can be completed now. The competition for Semester One begins early, (Week 3, Term 1). Our school can hopefully enter 3 teams in the Year 3-4 competition league organised by the Junior Breakers. When these three teams are full, then children will be placed on a "waiting to play" list. Children commit for the whole semester and should not have other commitments on Friday nights as playing times vary from week to week. As a team member, children must be available to attend practise sessions, to be confirmed by the coach once teams have been finalised. **A reminder to register will be sent out on the "SKOOL LOOP" App, Monday 3 February 2020.**

VENUE - The Breakers Training Venue, 7 Atlas Place, Mairangi Bay.

TIME - Semester One (Term 1 and 2): Friday 28 February – Friday 26 June 2020 (16 weeks). Games are played Friday afternoons between 3.45pm and 7.30pm.

FEES - \$149.00 per player which includes a \$20 uniform hire fee. Sunnynook Primary School has a **NO PAY/NO PLAY** policy therefore fees for these after-school sport competitions will be paid immediately upon registration via our ONLINE SHOP. Refunds will be made if there are not enough players to form a team.

REGISTRATION and PERMISSION- To register and make payment please go online to: <http://www.sunnynook.school.nz/96/pages/50-information> and click on the ONLINE PAYMENT link. Select the SPORTS service, and go to "Year 3/4 Junior Basketball - Term 1-2", and then click on the button with your child's first initial and follow the prompts. If you have not set up an account please do so (watch the tutorials on our website, if you need help). **Registrations close Sunday 9 February (no exceptions).**

UNIFORM – A school sports uniform is hired, at a cost of \$20.00 for two terms. Hired uniforms should only be worn for the duration of the game and not used any other time. Non-marking sport shoes are to be worn and no watches or jewellery allowed. **Mouth guards are compulsory.**

INFORMATION - For a team to enter this competition, there must be a minimum of 7 players in the team. Before every game at the venue there is a 10 - minute warm up with Breakers coaches giving our students the opportunity to learn new skills and the rules of the game, in each session. Breakers staff will be refereeing the games. Teams will be formed with much consideration, at the discretion of the school.

COACH – Our school will provide an opportunity for court time and it will be the coach's responsibility to ensure that their team practices on a weekly basis. It is also the coach's responsibility to attend their team's games and to provide support and guidance where necessary. The coach will work alongside the team manager.

MANAGER - The role of the manager is to inform parents of their child's weekly game time and email parents any other relevant information. The managers will work alongside the team coach and attend their team's games. Results of the game including the player of the day information can be emailed using a template to the school's secretary each week, so that it can appear in the school's newsletter fortnightly. This can be emailed by 3.00pm on Tuesdays.
