VENUE - Pinehurst School, 75 Bush Rd, Albany.

TIME - Saturdays - 11 May to 29 June (excluding Queen's Birthday) and from 27 July to 7 September (14 weeks. Games are from 8.45am until mid-afternoon.

FEES - \$72.00 per player which includes a \$20 uniform hire fee. Sunnynook Primary School has a NO PAY/NO PLAY policy therefore fees for these after-school sport competitions will be paid immediately upon registration via our ONLINE SHOP. Refunds will be made if there are not enough players to form a team.

REGISTRATION and PERMISSION - To register and make payment, please go online to: <http://www.sunnynook.school.nz/96/pages/50-information> and click on the ONLINE PAYMENT link. Select the SPORTS service, and go to "Netball Y1-4 Term 2-3, 2019", and then click on the button with your child's first initial and follow the prompts. If you have not set up an account please do so (watch the tutorials on our website, if you need help). **Registrations close Tuesday 12 March**

UNIFORM - Hired uniforms should only be worn for the duration of the game and not used any other time. If undergarments are to be worn, please ensure they are navy or black only. Hair must be tied back, nails short, and no watches or jewellery allowed. Mouth Guards are compulsory.

INFORMATION - For a team to enter this competition, there must be a minimum of 8 players in the team. Kidzplay Netball offers an environment for children to have the opportunity to have fun while learning ball skills, teamwork, fair play and the pure enjoyment of playing a sport. Year 1 play a non-competitive league 6-a-side version of netball and Year 2-4 play a 7-a-side variance to rules that ensure the players grow into the full game as they mature. COACH - Our school will provide an opportunity for court time and it will be the coach's responsibility to ensure that their team practices on a weekly basis. It is also the coach's responsibility to attend their team's games and to provide support and guidance where necessary. The coach will work alongside the team manager.

MANAGER - The role of the manager is to inform parents of their child's weekly game time and email parents any other relevant information. All draws and related information can be found on www.kidzplaynetball.co.nz. The manager will work alongside the team coach supporting them when necessary and attending their team's games. Managers will organise the collection of umpire fees and be familiar with the scorecard procedure. Results of the game, including the player of the day fortnightly information, can be emailed using a template to the school's secretary, so that it can appear in the school's newsletter. This must be emailed by 3.00pm on Tuesdays.
