INFORMATION - To ensure your child is placed in a team for Semester Two's competition, please register your child's interest through our ONLINE SHOP on our school's website, as soon as possible. Children commit for the whole semester and should not have other commitments on game night as playing times vary from week to week. As a team member, children must be available to attend practise sessions, to be confirmed by the coach once teams have been finalised.

VENUE - The Breakers Training Venue, 7 Atlas Place, Mairangi Bay.

TIME - Semester Two (Term 3 and 4): (18 weeks).
Sunnynook Primary Team THUNDER, play Monday 20 July – Monday 30 November 2020.
Games are played on Monday, in the afternoons between 3.45pm and 7.00pm.

FEES - Returning players using credit from Semester 1: \$30.00 per player (includes uniform hire).
New joining players: \$120.00 per player (includes uniform hire).

Sunnynook Primary School has a **NO PAY/NO PLAY** policy therefore fees for these after-school sport competitions will be paid immediately upon registration via our ONLINE SHOP. Refunds will be made if there are not enough players to form a team.

REGISTRATION and PERMISSION - To register and make payment please go online to: <http://www.sunnynook.school.nz/96/pages/50-information> and click on the ONLINE PAYMENT link. Select the SPORTS service, and go to "Year 1/2 BASKETBALL - Term 3-4", and then click on the button with your child's first initial and follow the prompts. If you have not set up an account please do so (watch the tutorials on our website, if you need help). **Registrations are to be completed, Sunday 21 June 2020.**

UNIFORM – A school sports uniform is hired, at a cost of \$20.00 for two terms. Hired uniforms should only be worn for the duration of the game and not used any other time. Non-marking sport shoes are to be worn and no watches or jewellery allowed. **Mouth Guards are compulsory.**

INFORMATION - For a team to enter this competition, there must be a minimum of 7 players in the team. Before every game at the venue there is a 10 - minute warm up with Breakers coaches giving our students the opportunity to learn new skills and the rules of the game, in each session. Breakers staff will be refereeing the games.

COACH - Our school will provide an opportunity for court time and it is the coach's responsibility to ensure that their team practises on a weekly basis. The coach will attend their team's games providing support and guidance where necessary. The coach will work alongside the team manager.

MANAGER - The role of the manager is to inform parents of their child's weekly game time and email parents any other relevant information. The managers will work alongside the team coach and attend their team's games. Game results can be emailed weekly using a template, to the school's secretary by Tuesday 3pm. Results will then appear in the school's fortnightly newsletter.
