



2019 Year 5-6 Netball Winter League - Registration Information - Term 2 and Term 3

* Registrations close Tuesday 5 March

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

VENUE - North Harbour Netball, AMI Centre, Northcote.

TIME - Year 5 and 6 teams play Wednesday nights. Games round times are between 4.00pm and 6.30pm. The season starts on 1 May and goes through to 28 August 2019. There is no play during the July school holidays.

TRIALS - During school hours at 11.00am (middle block) on Thursday, 7 March. To ensure a fair-selection an independent selector from Netball North Harbour will attend. Children must have suitable sport shoes on the day to participate in the trials. After these trials the school will confirm the chosen teams and the children will be informed. Coaches, managers and umpire roles will also be notified.

FEES - \$100.00 per player which includes a \$20 uniform hire fee. Sunnynook Primary School has a NO PAY/NO PLAY policy, therefore fees for these after-school sport competitions will be paid immediately upon registration via our ONLINE SHOP. Refunds will be made if there are not enough players to form a team.

REGISTRATION and PERMISSION - To register and make payment, please go online to: <http://www.sunnynook.school.nz/96/pages/50-information> and click on the ONLINE PAYMENT link. Select the SPORTS service, and go to "Netball Y5-6 Term 2-3, 2019", and then click on the link with your child's first initial and follow the prompts. If you have not set up an account please do so (watch the tutorials on our website, if you need help). Registrations close Tuesday 5 March.

NETBALL NORTH HARBOUR REGISTRATION - Players not already registered with Netball North Harbour will be required to also register online with NNH www.netballnorthharbour.co.nz (this will apply to any new Year 5 or 6 players). A reminder for all players that played last year, to update your details online.

UNIFORM - Hired uniforms should only be worn for the duration of the game and not used any other time. Hair must be tied back, nails short, and no watches or jewellery allowed.

INFORMATION - For a team to enter this competition, there must be a minimum of 8 players in the team. Boys are welcome. Year 5 teams play Kiwi netball where they rotate positions each quarter, therefore experiencing up to four positions each game. Year 6 teams play traditional netball (fixed positions) so children play to their strengths and prepare for netball at Intermediate level. The competition is 14 weeks long and includes 7 grading games and 7 competition games. All teams playing in this competition supply their own coach, manager and umpire.

COACH - Our school will provide an opportunity for court time and it will be the coach's responsibility to ensure that their team practices on a weekly basis. It is also the coach's responsibility to attend their team's games and to provide support and guidance where necessary. The coach will work alongside the team manager.

MANAGER - The role of the manager is to inform parents of their child's weekly game time and email parents any other relevant information. The managers will work alongside the team coach supporting them when necessary and attending their team's games. Results of the game, including the player of the day fortnightly information, can be emailed using a template to the school's secretary, so that it can appear in the school's newsletter. This must be emailed by 3.00pm on Tuesdays.
